Large classes may be compensated at higher rates. Classes which normally have a cap of forty, for example, but that are expanded to accommodate up to eighty students, may be classified as a double load (i.e., six credit hours instead of three)s

Dual Credit courses may carry these additional stipends: \$100 per section for the cooperating college instructor to do grade entry; \$200 per section for the cooperating college instructor to make classroom visits and do grade entry

Studio Art Classes may be compensated at higher rates. Three credit studio arts classes are normally compensated at the four credit hour rate.

Science Labs may be compensated at higher rates. One credit science labs are normally compensated at the three credit hour rate.
